5. Anonymous Call Rejection (ACR) (Continued) the live operator surcharge amount to the aforementioned party's telephone bill. Furthermore, should alternative methods become available in the future which permit the aforementioned to access the ACR party without revealing the caller's telephone number, the Company will waive any additional charges associated with such alternative methods.

7. Call Trace - traces the number of the last call received. After receiving a call, which is to be traced, depress and release the receiver button. When customer receives a dial tone, press *57 from a touch tone phone or 1-1-5-7 from a rotary/pulse phone. Listen for the confirmation announcement and hang up. Subscriber must do this each time subscriber wants to trace a call. The number of the last call will now be recorded at the Telephone Company. The subscriber will not receive the number of the party who called. The information will be held by the Telephone Company for release to the police or other legally constituted authorities upon customer authorization. The customer is required to contact the telephone company for further action.

If a subscriber receives another call or Call Waiting tone before subscriber activates the trace of an unwanted call and then activates Call Trace, subscriber will trace the second call, not the one subscriber was trying to trace. The system will trace only the last call received.

This service is only available on a per usage basis.
